## FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT (A) 13th March, 2011

Yesterday, along with the group from our Parish, I went along to the Rite of Election at our Cathedral in Portsmouth. This liturgy, which is celebrated this weekend in Cathedrals throughout the world, is the occasion when the Bishop of each diocese welcomes and invites those who wish to become Catholics to join us at the Easter Vigil.

The names of about 200 men and women were called yesterday to be greeted by the Bishop so that they could return to their parishes and complete their Lenten preparation for Baptism or reception into the Church. Those who are preparing for Baptism are called 'Catechumens' and at the Rite of Election they become the 'Elect' which means they have been chosen for Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Communion at Easter. Those who are already baptised are known as candidates for reception into the full communion of the Catholic Church at Easter.

These Catechumens and Candidates join us all in the Lenten journey which is now well underway. Lent is given to us as an opportunity to deepen our relationship with the Lord through works of charity, prayer and self-denial.

The names of our Catechumens are Angharad Foster and Michael Shields and our candidates are Ben Huntley, Roy Cochran, Clare Croft Bunty Attwood and Francis Chamberlain. Please keep them in your prayer. PJT

## PARISH CENTRE DEVELOPMENT

The main contractors have been appointed following a competitive tender process. Feltham Construction, who were also the main contractors for the Douai Abbey Library and Refectory, will start on site at the end of March and will be using the St Peter Street entrance for all their work throughout the project. We will publish the start of the different phases of the build just before they happen. The initial work will involve preparing the site including levelling, putting the office and portacabins on site and completing the archaeology supervision condition during the drilling of the foundation piles and ground source heat pump bore holes. The build cost remains within the original estimates of £1.3m made at the beginning of the project. The programme for the build should mean that the building will be weathertight by October and handed over to the parish by Easter 2012. The parish's pastoral centre project committee and the Finance and Property Committee will continue to supervise the project in terms of cost, quality and programme time and further details will be on the parish website.
