## SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT (A) 20th March, 2011

Our Lenten journey is now well underway and we will have established those special observances we want to adopt. In today's Gospel we are given a glimpse of the journeys completion; both the Lenten journey and the journey of life.

As Jesus is transfigured, his power and presence as the risen one and the light of the world is revealed. In the beauty and exhilaration of the transfiguration we see the new creation which the resurrection of Jesus brings into being. The death and resurrection of Jesus transforms the creation of which he is part and which was created through him and the Spirit of God is present and active in a new way, because Jesus 'abolished death and has proclaimed life and immortality through the Good News.'

Our full experience of the resurrection will be God's gift to us when our journey is complete. The gift of the Holy Spirit means that it is present reality as well, which is where our life and mission as Christians becomes relevant. Our present lives, filled with the Spirit, are all about making visible and recognisable the new creation. The more our lives can be modelled on that of Jesus, the more effective we shall be. ## **PARISH CENTRE DEVELOPMENT**

The main contractors have been appointed following a competitive tender process. Feltham Construction, who were also the main contractors for the Douai Abbey Library and Refectory, will start on site at the end of March and will be using the St Peter Street entrance for all their work throughout the project. We will publish the start of the different phases of the build just before they happen. The initial work will involve preparing the site including levelling, putting the office and portacabins on site and completing the archaeology supervision condition during the drilling of the foundation piles and ground source heat pump bore holes. The build cost remains within the original estimates of £1.3m made at the beginning of the project. The programme for the build should mean that the building will be weathertight by October and handed over to the parish by Easter 2012. The parish's pastoral centre project committee and the Finance and Property Committee will continue to supervise the project in terms of cost, quality and programme time and further details will be on the parish website.
