## THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT (A) 27th March, 2011

The Catechism begins with the statement that within the makeup of every human being is the desire for God. We desire many things, sometimes, often, human freewill goes wrong, our desires become misdirected, but all human desire is ultimately the desire to return to our creator. We are, as it were, programmed for transcendence.

In the Gospel today it is the other way round. God thirsts for us. The woman comes to draw water from the well. She is thirsty, but Christ's thirst for her faith awakens her true thirst, which is spiritual. He stands before us asking for our faith, and that gentle but authoritative plea can awaken faith in us.

It is God's desire for us which is the origin of our innate desire for God. Our hearts are restless for God because he is restless for us. The preface of today's Mass says it all:

When he asked the woman of Samaria for water to drink, Christ had already prepared for her the gift of faith. In his thirst to receive her faith, he awakened in her heart the fire of your love.

For those adults who are preparing for Baptism at Easter, this Sunday is special. The Gospel of the Samaritan Woman will be read and we hear how she was offered 'Living Water' by Jesus. A gift described by Jesus as water that 'will turn into a spring within, welling up to eternal life'. Those preparing for Baptism will hear that Jesus is the fountain for which they thirst.

Whether we are preparing for Christian Initiation, reception into the full communion of the Catholic Church or, as existing members of the Church, to renew our baptismal commitment at Easter, all of us acknowledge that Jesus is the 'spring welling up to eternal life' and that all our desires point to him because he is 'the way, the truth and the life.' Special prayers will be said for those preparing for Baptism and one of them asks that each person will be set free from 'reliance on self' and the 'spirit of deceit'. For us all, the tendency is that extreme self-reliance and all manner of deceit will close us to the love of God and the 'living water' which he is constantly offering. The Sacrament of Penance is offered to us so that we might be released from those things which close us to the presence and action of God in our lives. Please come along to one of our Penitential Liturgies on Saturday, 16th April or Monday, 18th April.

Please note that on the 10th April there will be no Stations of the Cross and Benediction because of Fr. Paul's installation at 3.30pm in Winchester Cathedral.

### **PARISH CENTRE DEVELOPMENT**

The main contractors have been appointed following a competitive tender process. Feltham Construction, who were also the main contractors for the Douai Abbey Library and Refectory, will start on site on the 4th April and will be using the St Peter Street entrance for all their work throughout the project. We will publish the start of the different phases of the build just before they happen. The initial work will involve preparing the site including levelling, putting the office and portacabins on site and completing the archaeology supervision condition during the drilling of the foundation piles and ground source heat pump bore holes. The build cost remains within the original estimates of £1.3m made at the beginning of the project. The programme for the build should mean that the building will be weathertight by October and handed over to the parish by Easter 2012. The parish's pastoral centre project committee and the Finance and Property Committee will continue to supervise the project in terms of cost, quality and programme time and further details will be on the parish website.
